Interested in becoming a substitute teacher in the Elk Grove Unified School District (EGUSD)? If so, and you have a **bach**elor's degree, here is some information we think you may find of interest.

As you might be aware, California is in the midst of a severe substitute teacher shortage and the first step our Board of Education took to address this was on October 6, 2015, when they approved an increase to the pay rates of certificated substitute teachers. The shortage directly impacts the District's ability to provide critical training for the implementation of the Common Core State Standards and the New Generation Science Standards, and it affects the overall commitment to ensuring the most effective instructional strategies are employed in the classroom. To this end, EGUSD has a significant need to increase its pool of substitute teachers.

We are reaching out to our community to encourage you to consider serving as a Substitute Teacher, or encourage a qualified family member or friend to do the same. Substitute teachers serve a critical role in EGUSD's educational program and we strive to attract and retain a capable, informed, and trained pool of substitute teachers who can advance learning for all students when the teacher of record must be absent. This is an excellent opportunity to play a role in education and earn additional income. In addition to the pay increase and future learning opportunities, qualifying certificated substitutes will have the option to enroll in health benefits and earn one hour of sick leave for every thirty hours of service. The EGUSD Human Resources department can assist you with a fast-tracked process to fulfill these requirements.

EGUSD is also committed to training and developing its current and prospective substitute teachers and intends to host a comprehensive orientation to include classroom management techniques, culturally responsive teaching, and an overview of district curricula. Please see the substitute pay rates below. You may request to work at specific sites. Substitute teachers, although temporarily placed, can make a significant impact on the lives of children.


