F.S. 1012.22 (1)(c)3 For instructional personnel hired on or after July 1, 2011, credit for the advanced degree held must be in the individual's area of certification and paid as a salary supplement.

**Specialist Degree:** \$4,050.00 per year

**Doctorate Degree:** \$5,062.50 per year
