Teachers not previously employed by the District are allowed credit for a maximum of five years previous satisfactory teaching experience toward years necessary for receiving career increments.

<sup>\*</sup> QW is an abbreviation for a quadriweekly pay period. Pay warrants are issued to certificated employees in schools on traditional calendars at the end of each four week period (20 days) between September 1 and June 30 of each school year. Multiplication of QW rates by the appropriate index may not equal exact yearly salaries since computer does rounding.
