Professional Practice Instructions

Step 1: Weights for Professional Practices

Assign each standard a weight (total must equal 100) for calculating the overall Professional Practices rating (standards 1-4).

Step 2: Assign Element Level Proficiency

Assign each element a proficiency rating of Level 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5. These are the peach colored boxes; when you click on them, a drop down menu is provided. (To clear the cell of ratings: right click in the cell and choose clear contents.)

Once assigned, the table below provides you with the rating information for each standard and the overall Professional Practice rating.

These are the peach colored boxes; when you click on them, a drop down menu is provided. **(To clear the cell of any ratings- right click in the cell and choose clear contents.)**
