Dear Colleague:

The following UMaine Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) students have expressed an interest in doing their student teaching internship in your school system. In some cases, a particular teacher may have been suggested either because the teacher candidate requested this placement or because the teacher has hosted a student teacher in the past. If this meets with your approval, please indicate the teachers to whom the teacher candidates will be assigned and return the request form to me. Please keep in mind that, in most cases, the college requires that the mentor teacher have at least three years of teaching experience, and in your estimation, will be influential in making a positive impact on the teacher candidate's professional development.

Our teacher candidates are required to successfully pass the CHRC/fingerprint requirement, the Praxis I Exams, and Praxis II Exam before they may begin their internship. A number of our teacher candidates are in the process of completing this requirement this semester. They are also required to have a personal interview with the teacher before final acceptance; therefore, this is only a tentative commitment.

We are including a student profile written by the teacher candidate we are seeking to place. We hope this will give the potential mentor teacher a starting point for making a decision to work with the teacher candidate.

Please feel free to make other assignments if the suggested placement teacher is not available, chooses not to mentor a teacher candidate at this time, or does not meet minimum requirements. In no case should the teacher candidate make his/her own arrangements with a teacher without your approval.

Because I have a large number of teacher candidates to place for the spring semester, your prompt consideration of these requests would be greatly appreciated.
